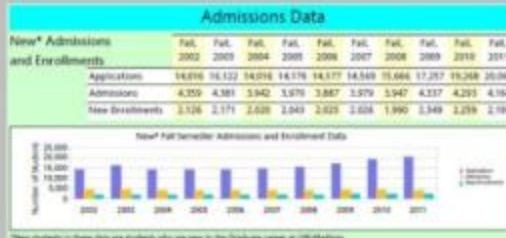
These new and improved profiles help graduate coordinators, faculty, administrators, program-reviewers, students, and the rest of the University community gather and analyze graduate-program related data.

Changes include:

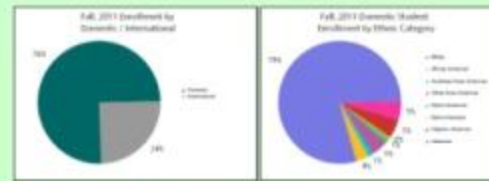
- Incorporation of ten years of data into one snapshot
